

## Curriculum Coverage Overview – Autumn Term 1 2018/2019

### Personal, Social and emotional development:

We will be focusing on working together and developing ways to share and take turns. We will be learning to become independent in how we solve problems with peers and how to behave appropriately in different situations.

### Communication, Language and literacy:

The children will be exploring lots of different stories. They will discover different sounds relating to the stories that will help them match sounds to words. Children will share experiences and ask questions enabling them to expand their vocabulary.

### Physical Development:

The children will be developing their co-ordination, balance and movement. They will also be focussing on improving their ball skills. They will be working on their fine motor skills through play-dough models, threading beads, cutting and sticking, writing/drawing and painting.

## Reception Class

### Mathematics:

We shall be doing lots of maths activities, including counting to 20 and counting back from 10. We will be beginning to recognise numbers that are 'one less' and 'one more'. We shall also be continuing to sort items using our knowledge about differences.



### Expressive Arts and design:

We will be exploring role-play, singing Nasheeds and different movements as we learn about ourselves, develop our own preferences for expression and build our confidence.

### Islamic Studies:

This term in Islamic studies we will be covering the following topics:

- Who am I? Who is a Muslim? (Aqidah)
- Saying Salaam (Personal development)
- Saying Bismillah (Personal development)
- Who created everything? (Aqidah)
- Story of Adam (as) (Tareekh)
- Islamic months Songs
- How to use the toilet (Fiqh)

### Qaaidah:

To recognise the Arabic letters from Alif to yaa in standalone form (sequence).

To recognise the Arabic letters Alif to yaa in standalone form (random).

### Surah and Dua memorisation:

- Surah Fatihah
- 1<sup>st</sup> Kalimah
- Before starting something

### Understanding of the world:

The children will learn about special celebrations that we experience through role-play and discussion.
