

Curriculum Coverage Overview – Autumn Term 1 2018/2019

Year 2

English: Fairy tales – Jack and the beanstalk.

The children will be indulging into the fairy tales they grew up reading. They will be studying Jack and the beanstalk in greater depth. For example; the setting, characters and climax. They will be exploring the author's rich vocabulary and investigate grammar and punctuation. Lastly, they will be writing their own version of the fairy tale.

Maths:

This term Year 2 will learn to:

- Count objects to 100 and read and write numbers in numerals and words
- Represent numbers to 100 using a range of materials
- Partition a two digit number into tens and ones and understand what each digit represents
- Understand tens and ones using addition
- Use a place value chart
- Compare and order objects and numbers
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s and the in 3's
- Learn fact families – Addition and subtraction bonds to 20
- Check calculations and Compare number sentences
- Related facts e.g. if $2+5=7$ then $20+50=70$
- Learn number bonds to 100 (tens)

D.T: Human structure

Children will be partaking in a class project whereby they will be making a human structure with pipe cleaners, this will include children using their fine motor skills, understanding tying, weaving, knotting. They will be exploring their likes, dislikes and improving their work through evaluation.

PSHCE: Right and wrong

Through the unit children will be looking at attitudes to what is right and wrong, fair and unfair and how it differs according to age, culture, era and other social circumstances in which we live. However, somethings such as murder and stealing are universally regarded as wrong.



PE: The children will be exploring movement ideas and respond imaginatively to a range of stimuli. They will be challenged to remember, repeat and link a range of actions with coordination.

RE: Myself – The children will be exploring key people in their life, recognising their own feelings and those of others. They will also be studying the importance of respecting other people's beliefs and traditions. The term will be ending on the topic of dealing with anger and how one must always reflect and consider religious and spiritual feelings.

Science: Humans

Throughout this unit the children will be exploring basic needs of human survival. They will be describing the importance for humans of exercise and learn about eating the right amount of different types of food as well hygiene.

History: Famous activists

The children will be studying famous activists Rosa Parks and Mala Yousafzai. They will be learning about events beyond living memory that are significant globally and the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to international achievements.

Islamic Studies: Fiqh
