

Curriculum Coverage Overview – Autumn Term 1 2018/2019

Year 3

English

Fiction: Greek Myths and Legends: Children read, explore and discuss myths; role-play and retell myths from different perspectives. They research and write their own myths, presenting them to an audience.

Grammar includes: Using and recognising nouns, adjectives and adjectival phrases. Using conjunctions to express time and cause and using possessive apostrophes with singular and plural nouns.

Performance poetry: The children will learn to identify distinctive features such as repetition, rhyme, rhythm, alliteration and the use of oral language based on speech. They will also rehearse and perform their poems and evaluate each other's contributions.

Science

In this unit children recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light. They recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes. They also learn that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object.

History

Through discussion, children understand the terms 'invaders' and 'settlers' and discuss motivations for emigration. They will gain historical insight into the lives of Anglo-Saxon and British people.

Geography

The children will learn about the Anglo-Saxon invasions; the routes, the kingdoms, the ancient roads, their warriors and the historical sources that we use.

Art:

Having found out about the way Anglo Saxons made their own clothes, children will try their hand at dyeing using natural dyes (if possible) and weaving some fabric.



PE

PE DAY:

THURSDAY

We will be studying invasion games and will focus on team work, keeping possession, scoring & defending.

RE

We will be looking at the principal events and stories in Jesus' life that forms the basis of the Christian belief.

Maths:

This term Year 3 will learn to:

- Use multiple of 5 and 10 bonds to 100 to solve additions and subtractions
- Add and subtract 2-digit numbers
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 5, 10, 2, 4 and 3 times-tables
- Understand the calendar, including days, weeks, months, years
- Tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes on analogue and digital clocks
- Understand the properties of 3D shapes

PSHE:

In this unit, the children will develop their understanding and skills in three key social and emotional aspects of learning: empathy, managing feelings and social skills.

Islamic Studies - Aqaaid

The children will be studying the following topics: Messengers, Qiyyamah, Minor signs, List of the major signs.

Hadeeth: Salaah and Love for others.

Surah and Duaa Memorisation

Review surahs and duaas from year 1 and 2. **Surah Bayyinah**, 5th Kalimah , When you see someone smiling.

Qaaidah/Quraan

To practice recitation of the Quraan with fluency. To implement the rules of tajweed.
