

Curriculum Coverage Overview – Spring Term 2 2021/2022

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

This term, the children will be supported to recognise their personal achievement and set up their own goals. They will have opportunities to reflect, talk and evaluate their work with their peers. They will look at ways they can avoid certain actions and behaviours that can lead to conflict but also how they can resolve conflicts in a peaceful and friendly way.

Communication, Language and Literacy:

As part of our topic on 'Animals', the children will learn new vocabulary and have opportunities to ask and respond to 'why' questions. They will continue to write simple sentences adding more detail and making sure they practise pre-cursive letter formation and include finger spaces. They will also be looking at writing their own animal chatter poem.

Physical Development:

The children will learn to travel confidently around, under, over and through different equipment and learn to balance with confidence. Dance related activities in the stage area. Provide opportunities for children to, spin, rock, tilt, fall, slide and bounce.

The children will continue using a range of mark making tools to develop fine motor skills and pencil control.

Reception Class

Mathematics:

The children will represent, sort, compare and order numbers up to ten. They will explore different ways to make ten. The children will explore 3D shapes and will recap patterns and sequences. They will build numbers beyond ten and count patterns beyond ten.

Expressive Arts and Design:

Using different media materials, the children will create constructions different animals.

The children will have the opportunity to perform the Ramadan assembly.

Islamic Studies:

This term in Islamic studies, we will be covering the following topics:

- Articles of faith (Aqidah) Allah, Angels, Books, Messengers, Last day and Qadr.
- Prophet Yunus (Aṣ) (History)
- Paradise and hell (Aqidah)
- Sharing (Fiqh)
- Story of Musa (Aṣ) (History) Part 1
- Story of Musa (Aṣ) (History) Part 2

Qaidah:

To read 3 or 4 letter words with a fathah, dhammah or kasrah.

Surah and Duaa Memorisation:

- Surah Naas
- 5 names of Allah
- Duaa before and after drinking water
- 2nd Kalimah
- Shahaadah

Understanding of the World:

The children will learn different facts and features of animals all around the world. They will look at similarities and differences between things in the past and now such as zoo and safari.

The children will investigate why some animals migrate and therefore explore seasonal changes.
