

## Curriculum Coverage Overview – Autumn Term 2 2021/2022

### Year 1

#### English: 'Lost and Found', Monster Poetry and Non-Fiction Texts

This term, the children will explore, interpret and respond to the picture book 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. The children will broaden their understanding and use of appropriate vocabulary to write character descriptions and narratives.

The children will also develop their poetry skills by writing a Monster poem based on readings of other Monster Poetry. Additionally, Year 1 will read non-fiction texts about polar bears and woolly mammoths and base their writing on creating their own reports about these animals.

#### Science: Non-Flowering Plants and Seasons

This term, the children will continue to identify the different features of the four seasons, understanding how temperature changes affect weather, the different types of weather we experience and its affect on the duration of night and day. The children will also be exploring how to classify plants into evergreen and deciduous plants.

#### Geography: Let's Go to the Arctic!

In this unit, the children will learn about geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country. They will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom as well as the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and North and South Poles. They will also learn to use world maps, atlases and globes to identify countries, continents and oceans.

#### Arabic

In Arabic this term, the children will learn to:

- Name classroom objects - key phrases will be: What is this? This is a pen. Where is the rubber? Etc.
- Ask personal information - key phrases will be: Asking people about their age.
- Describe their home – i.e. rooms in their house, describe furniture in different rooms, etc.

#### Art: Inuit Art

In Art, the children will be exploring artwork produced by Inuit people who come from the Arctic. The children will be creating their own Inuit masterpieces, focusing on intricate designs enabling them to develop their fine motor skills. They will also work on expressing themselves through bright colours and patterns.



#### RE: Celebrations

In RE this term, the children will be investigating different religious Christian celebrations and festivals like Baptism and Weddings by expressing ideas using art and design.

#### PE: Yoga Salute to the Sun

In PE, the children will be exploring a yoga sequence, which comprises of a full range of movements and incorporates forward bends, backbends, inversions, twists and balances. The children will expand their range of yoga poses and how they transition between them.

**PE DAY: WEDNESDAY**

#### Maths: Addition & Subtraction (within 10), Shape & Place Value (within 20)

This term, the children will focus on addition and subtraction. The children will learn the concept of the part-whole model, number bonds and fact families, as well as become familiar with the addition and subtraction symbols and application to sums.

The children will also explore shapes, recognising, naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes and creating patterns with 2D and 3D shapes.

Additionally, the children will learn about place value, counting forwards and backwards and writing numbers to 20 in numerals and words. They will be learning to count from 11 to 20, identifying one more and one less, comparing and ordering groups of objects and numbers.

#### Computing: Internet Safety

This term, the children will be focusing on taking ownership of their creative work, searching the internet safely, being S.M.A.R.T online, protecting their personal information and sending emails.

#### Islamic Studies: Fiqh

In Islamic Studies, the children will be learning the basic beliefs of a Muslim. They will be covering the following topics: basic introduction to five pillars of Islam (shahadah, salaah, zakah, saum & hajj), introduction to taharah, keeping clean, how to use the toilet, why we do wudhu, method of wudhu, things that break wudhu, names of the 5 daily prayers and basic salaah positions.

**Hadeeth:** Helping others.

#### Surah and Duaa Memorisation

Review surahs and duaas from Reception class.

**Surahs:** Surah Lahab and Surah Nasr

**Duaas:** Making intention to do something and duaah when seeing a muslim happy.

#### Qaaidah

To understand sukoon and its purpose of joining letters. To learn the 6 places to stretch harakahs.
