

## Curriculum Coverage Overview – Autumn Term 2 2021/2022

### Year 5

#### English: Goodnight, Mr Tom

Set in 1939, this story focuses on a boy's life as an evacuee in World War II. The children explore dialogue to enhance characterisation, explore characters and write their own narrative. They also learn to write a political address and perform their speech to create impact.

**Private Peaceful (Fiction):** In this unit, the children explore a tale of two brothers before the war. They learn to write character description, use persuasive language to write their own speech and use description to write about a setting. The children also identify features of an obituary before writing one.

**Space Poetry:** Linked to their topic of the Solar System in Science, the children will write a poem on Space.

#### DT: Space Helmets

In D&T, the children will explore & investigate the different materials used in clothing for space wear. The children will work towards designing and making their own space helmet for an astronaut.



#### Maths

**This term, Year 5 will focus on:**

**Multiplication & Division:** Building on their times table knowledge children will find multiples and factors of whole numbers. Children will explore numbers that only have two factors called prime numbers, square numbers – which occur when a whole number is multiplied by itself and cube numbers – when a whole number is multiplied by itself three times. Children will recap multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 and learn to divide and multiply by 1,000.

**Perimeter & Area:** Children will recap measuring the perimeter of rectilinear shapes with and without grids. Children will explore calculating perimeter of rectangles using a formula as well as using addition and subtraction to calculate missing sides. They will also learn how to calculate area of compound and non-rectilinear shapes.

#### Science: Solar System and Seasons

In this topic, the children will be taught about the earth and its place in our Solar System. They will explore the moon and its craters, as well as being able to scientifically explain the different phases of the moon. The children will also gain an understanding in the science behind why we have solar and lunar eclipses.

#### History: World War 2

In History, the children will learn about World War II. They will learn when and why World War II began as well as find out about the key individuals and countries involved. In addition to this, they will discover all about evacuation; learn what it was like to live with food rationing and explore the contribution made by women to the war effort.

#### PE: Gymnastics

**PE DAY: Wednesday**

In this unit, the children will perform a variety of floor and vault movements. The children will learn how to perform stag jumps, split leaps, pike rolls, round-offs and the squat through vault. They will have the opportunity to put together their own sequences and routines to perform individually, as part of a pair or group.

#### Arabic

In Arabic this term, the children will learn to:

- Name classroom objects and equipment - key phrases will be: What is this? This is a pen. Where is the rubber? Etc.
- Ask personal information - key phrases will be: Asking people about their age, date of birth, etc.
- Use demonstrative pronoun: these
- Ask simple questions using 'What' and 'Why'
- Describe their home – i.e. rooms in their house, share opinions about their home, describe furniture in different rooms, etc.
- Use superlative adjectives

#### ICT: Internet safety

In this unit, the children will learn about e-safety with a focus on preventing and dealing with spam. They will scrutinise photographs that they see online and learn how easy it is to manipulate pictures and present them as reality.

#### RE: Worship

In this unit, the children will focus on different aspects of worship across different faiths. They will explore what worship is, what it means to religious believers and how believers' worship differently. Children will also be discussing the freedom of worship across the world.

#### Islamic Studies: Fiqh

Miscellaneous points of wudhu, tayammum in detail, Sunan of Salaah, Forbidden and disliked times of salaah, salaah of a masbuq, Qadha salaah, Eid salaah, Hajj and umrah, Ziyarah.

**Hadeeth:** Backbiting and intoxication

#### Surah and Duaa Memorisation

Review surah's and dua'a's from year 1,2, 3 and 4. Last 3 verses of Surah Hashr, dua'a for Protection from all calamities, dua'a for laylatul-qadr, dua'a on seeing a new moon, dua'a at the end of a gathering, dua'a when feeling pain, dua'a when visiting a sick person, dua'a when a loss or difficulty occurs, dua'a when angry.

#### Quraan

To practise recitation of the Quraan with fluency. To implement the rules of tajweed. **Tajweed revision:** Tawwudh, Tasmiyah, Full mouth letters, Qalqalah and Ghunnah.
