

Curriculum Coverage Overview – Autumn Term 2 2018/2019

Personal, Social and emotional development:

We will be learning about 'Getting on and falling out', how to deal with anger e.g. when someone has taken a toy, as well as Bonfire night, Halloween and safety. We will also be discussing stranger danger.

Communication, Language and literacy:

This term children will learn to:

- Form lower case letters correctly and to recognise upper case letters
- Recognise initial sounds and letters in words
- Blend sounds to make words
- Show an interest in illustrations and print in books
- Look at simple non-fiction texts, including recounts
- Learn to recognise high-frequency & familiar words

Understanding of the world:

We will be focussing on the difference between places, objects and living things as well as different environment features.

Expressive Arts and design:

We will be exploring how to mix colours and create different designs. We will also be using different movements to express our feelings during role-play to bring stories to life.

Mathematics:

We will be counting to 20 and back. We will be learning about size (big, small, little and large). We will also be attempting to do addition using our fingers and find one more/one less than a given number. We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes. Furthermore we will be exploring and identifying money and how to tell the time.



Physical Development:

We will be learning the development of movement individually and as part of a group. Children will be encouraged to respond to action rhymes. We will also be learning how to throw and catch a ball.
