

Curriculum Coverage Overview – Summer Term 1 – 2018/19

Year 1

English: Fiction: Traction Man

During this term the children will explore, interpret and respond to the picture book Traction Man. Children will identify the main events and characters, as well as comprehend the narrative plots and characters through role-play. Year 1 will also broaden their understanding and use of appropriate vocabulary to write character descriptions and narratives.

Non-fiction: Reports

The children will also be studying a range of non-chronological texts and discuss their features (diagrams, captions, subheadings and paragraphs). We will be discussing how reports can help us answer questions that we may have. Year 1 will also be planning, researching and writing their own report.

Science: Plants

Year 1 will be learning about outdoor plants, looking at different potatoes, exploring garden centres and seeds, as well as learning what is inside a flower.

By the end of the unit, the children will be able to name a variety of different plants, understand and describe how plants are suited to different habitats, and describe the structure of plants.

PSHCE: Choices

Year 1 will learn to understand that we all have a right to our own opinion, which we express in the choices we make. We will learn that choices have different consequences, as well as how to use money wisely and explore issues such as fairness.

PE: Football Skills

PE DAY: WEDNESDAY

Children will learn to master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching. Children will learn football skills such as dribbling, passing, shooting, turning and tricks.

D&T: Moving Toys/Puppets

In design and technology this term, the children will learn to sew a purposeful, functional and appealing puppet. This will help develop and mature their finger dexterity and fine motor skills, build self-confidence and learn copious amounts of patience.

Hand puppet play helps young children develop creative skills by forcing them to use their imaginations. They make up the roles, the rules, the situations and the solutions. The real world becomes more real to children who have opportunities to pretend.



History: Toys then and now

This term, Year 1 will study what toys are like now and what toys were like in the past. Children will also learn the similarities and differences between old and new toys as well as explore the ways in which we can tell 'old' from 'new'. They will also learn how the old toys were played with. Year 1 will visit the Toy Museum where they will interact and visually identify old and modern toys.

Maths: Multiplication, Division and Fractions

In Maths, children will focus on the following this term:

- Counting in 10's
- Making equal groups
- Making arrays
- Making doubles with numbers up to 20
- Making groups of an equal amount by starting with a given total
- Sharing objects into equal groups
- Find a half of shapes and sets of objects
- Find half of a small quantity
- Understand quarters as a shape or object being split up into four equal parts

Islamic Studies: Aadab

In Islamic Studies, the children will be learning about the aadab of classroom rules, good manners in the classroom, aadab of eating, drinking, sleeping and waking up and using the washroom.

Hadeeth: Ramadan

Surah and Dua Memorisation

Memorise: Surah Maoon and Surah Quraysh

Duas: Dua for drinking milk, Dua after waking up, 3rd kalimah, tamjeed and 10 names of Allah.

Qaaidah

Prolong the sound of a letter with madd.

Correctly read madds followed by a shaddah.

Recognise silent letters.

Identify and read letters of Muqattaat correctly.
