

Curriculum Coverage Overview – Summer Term 1 – 2018/19

Year 2

English: The Magic Finger by Roald Dahl

This term children will be exploring the story of 'The Magic Finger'. They will be introduced to Roald Dahls rich vocabulary and humour. Following the story, the children will be learning how to write a diary. They will be using and making connections to 'The Magic Finger'.

Letter writing

The children will learn about the features of a formal letter. Linked to the storybook, the children will write a formal letter to the council asking them to put an end to hunting.

Maths: Position and direction, problem solving and efficient methods.

This term Year 2 will learn to:

- Describe movement (clockwise/anti-clockwise)
- Describe turns (whole, half, quarter, three quarter)
- Describe movement and turns together
- Making patterns with shapes

They will also learn to tell and write the time, five minutes including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. They will learn the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.

Art: Under and over the sea

This term children will be learning to use different tools and materials to create sea animals, using different techniques such as tearing and cutting to create sea animals and sea collages. They will also be discovering watercolour paints to create underwater scenes. Finally, they will be learning to create patterns and different shades to give their collage depth.

PE: Football Skills

This term children will be introduced to key skills needed for different ball games, such as football, netball and basketball. They will be exploring different ways to move the ball, passing and receiving. They will gain an understanding of fitness and health in every session.



R.E: Beliefs

This unit examines the origins of some of the beliefs of the major religions. There is a focus on the holy books from Christianity, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism. The children will be exploring some of the holy books and understand why it is important to people of particular faiths. They will also have the opportunity to look at some similarities and differences.

Science: Habitats

Throughout this unit of work, the children will examine the plant and animal populations that exist in the local habitats and consider some of the adaptations of organisms to their surroundings. They will also learn about feeding relationships and food chains and are briefly introduced to the use of a simple key to help recognise and classify butterflies.

Geography: Underwater world

This term, children will be exploring sea around the UK and oceans all around the world. They will be discovering the underwater world and species that hold homes deep under. They will also learn to analyse simple maps and create their own maps using simple geographical vocabulary.

Islamic Studies: Aadaab (manners and Etiquettes)

Children will be learning the manners and etiquettes of the following:

Aadaab of: greeting, entering the house, speaking, sneezing, yawning, manners and friends.

Hadith: Ramadhan

Surah and Dua Memorisation:

Memorise: Surah Adiyaat, Surah Zilzaal, dua before wudhu, after wudhu, during wudhu, when entering the masjid, when leaving the masjid and after salaah.

Qaaidah:

To practice recitation of the Qaaidah/Juz Amma/Qur'an.
